Sant Antoni del Porquet

Mid-January

One of the oldest traditions of Finestrat is preserved through the celebration of 'Sant Antoni del Porquet ', the pig raising for the party. Formerly, it was the youth people who roamed the town houses collecting donations in the form of food and drink, which provided its neighbors.

Today, this tradition continues, visiting the people walking the pig and collecting donations from neighbors, and as a final point, it makes a material auction collected and the pig raffle among its participants.

Early February

Sant Joan

Night of 23 to 24 June

The festival is combined with group dances, food tasting, and as to tradition, a swim in the sea water is said on this date has some special qualities.
